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CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. Introduction

Internal Quality Audit (AMI) is a systemic, independent and documented testing process to ensure that the implementation of activities in university is in accordance with procedures and the results are in accordance with standards to achieve institutional goals. It is for the purpose of systemic, independent and documented testing that an Internal Quality Audit must be carried out. Quality Audit is not an assessment but rather a matching of conformity between implementation and planning of an activity/program. If an audit instrument or self-evaluation instrument carries out an assessment/scoring, then the assessment/scoring is only used to facilitate the formulation of recommendations for quality improvement, not to obtain a predicate or assessment. Internal Audit is an audit carried out to determine the level of conformity of the implementation of activities to the organization's own quality standards (Internal standards), Regulations, Procedures, Work Instructions. AMI is carried out by the Auditor on the Auditee, namely the organization/work unit/person being audited. An auditor is a person who has the ability to carry out audits, tasked with checking the conformity between all standards and implementation in units or sections of university.

The direct benefit of AMI is that it provides recommendations for improving the quality of universities, faculties and study programs within UIN Salatiga. These recommendations will be useful for university leaders in developing various programs to achieve the Vision of the University, Faculty or Study

Program. AMI is one of strategic efforts for institutional development and to determine the conformity of standards with the implementation that has been carried out in various aspects determined within the scope of AMI. AMI is more of an effort to improve quality, not an assessment. In this way, both auditors and auditees are on the same side, namely the side of improving the quality of the institution. Thus, quality audits are activities that need to be carried out internally with awareness and willingness from within the institution. In detail, the benefits of AMI for improving the performance and development of the UIN Salatiga institution are as follows:

1. Evaluation of institutional performance is more measurable with the availability of factual data that is up to date and specialized according to the nature and types of educational services available.
2. Assisting decision makers assess the performance of institutions, units and work equipment tactically and strategically based on continuous AMI findings.
3. Providing a reference for decision makers to formulate and determine the institution's priority scale in the short, medium and long term.
4. Improving the performance of UIN Salatiga institutions, units and devices in a climate of good and professional competition.
5. Communicate the goals of the university, the Higher Education Standards set by the university and the values that have been set.
6. Monitoring the achievement of conformity to objectives with standards and

measuring accountability for implementing standards

C. The Purpose of Internal Quality Audit

The purposes of implementing AMI at UIN Salatiga are:

1. Ensuring the quality management system meets the standart/regulation.

AMI searches for existing evidence to ensure that the quality management system implemented by the Auditee meets the established standards and does not conflict with Ministerial Regulations and BAN-PT.

2. Ensure the implementation of the quality management system in accordance with the targets/objectives. AMI carries out an analysis of the conformity or non-conformity of the quality standard implementation process and looks for the root of the problem to find space for improvement.
3. Evaluate the effectiveness of implementing the quality assurance system. AMI checks the results of quality achievement by referring to the Standard Achievement Indicators so that the scale of achievement can be determined.
4. Identify opportunities for improving the quality assurance system. AMI identifies the root of the problem and reports it to the Auditee as a basis for further quality improvement.

B. Mechanism of Audit Implementation

AMI is carried out through stages summarized in a detailed cycle in the

following 10 stages:

1. Establish audit objectives
2. Plan an annual audit
3. Determine the objectives and scope of the audit
4. Form an audit team
5. Review documents and prepare checklists (system audit)
6. Organize audit team meetings
7. Establish an audit schedule
8. Carry out an audit at the location of the audit object (compliance audit)
9. Prepare audit reports [Findings (KTS, OB) & PTK]
10. Conduct a review by management

These 10 stages are illustrated in Figure 1 as follows:

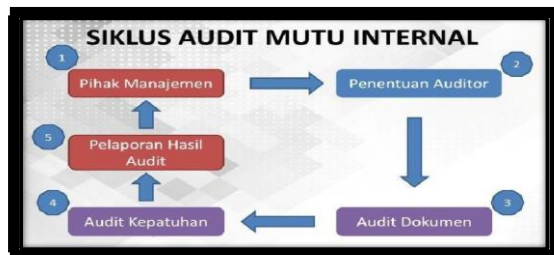


Quality Audit Cycle

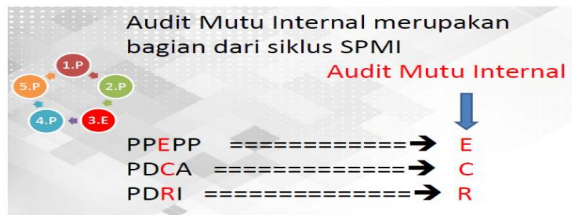

Findings on the implementation of AMI for each Study Program will immediately carry out continuous improvements. Thus, the academic quality of the Study Program is guaranteed.

The 2022 AMI activity report has been completed. Hopefully it will be useful for developing and improving academic quality, especially study programs within IAIN Salatiga.

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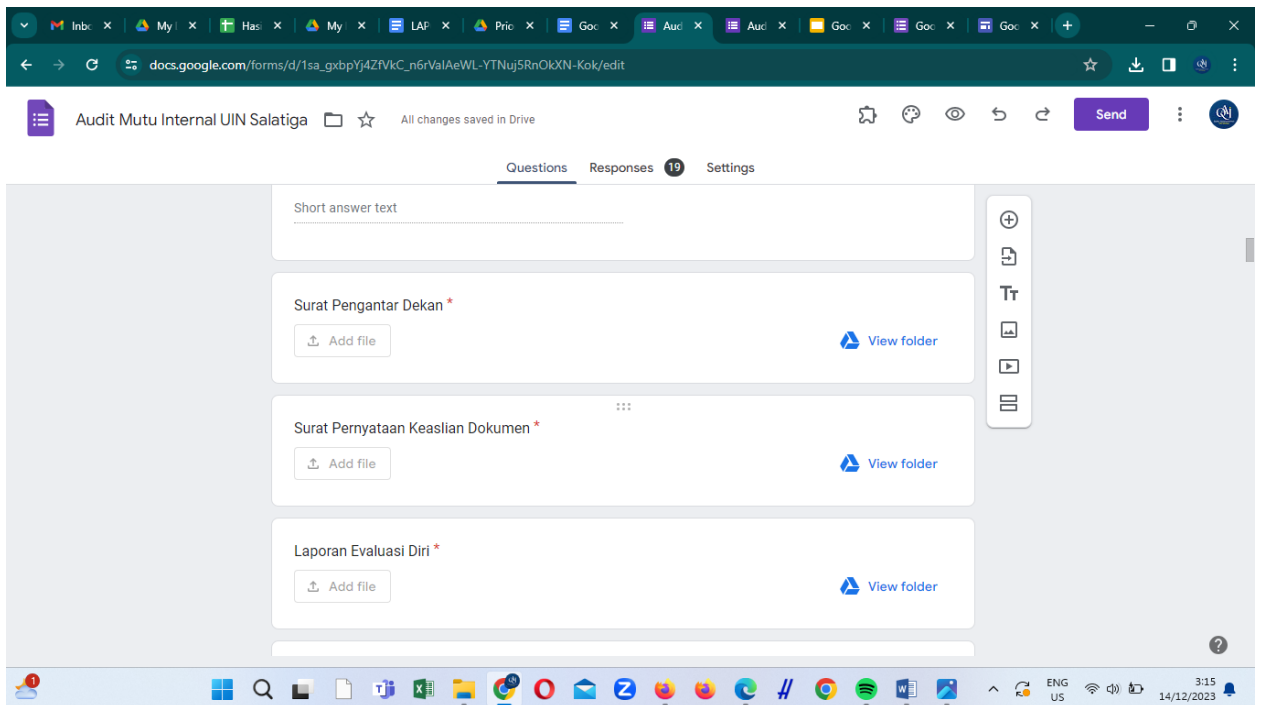
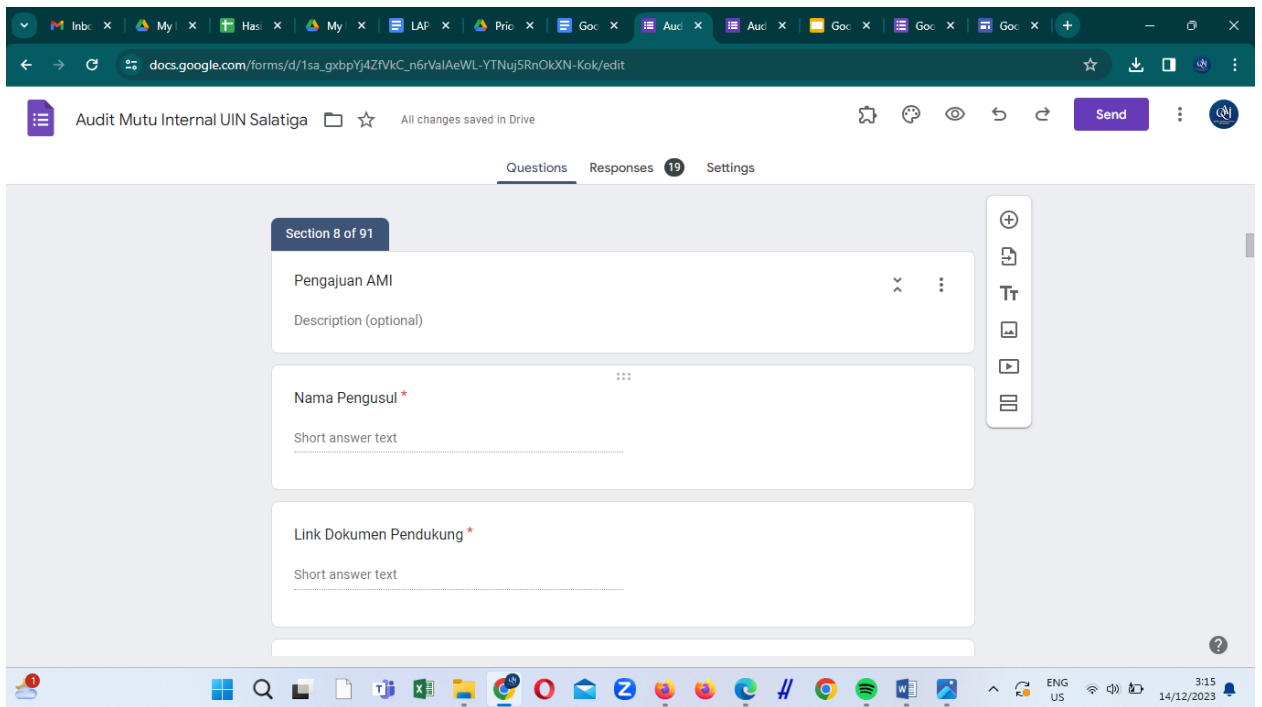
